Five people and the Kiwanis Club of Park Forest were honored at our Hall of Fame Induction. Our programs were, Jane Nicoll, "Park Forest Slide Show in Honor of 70th Anniversary" and museum tour; Arnold De Luca, former Park Forest resident, speaking on early Park Forest and his accomplishments including scans of his 5 scrapbooks. In February we held a Panel Discussion with early African American Residents of Park Forest, in May, we held our Ice Cream Social to appreciate our volunteers with Warren Brown performing, "Catch the Twain."

The "70th Anniversary of Park Forest" was on display in the museum all year, along with a special exhibit of "Design Through the Decades." The museum always tells the story of what life was like in Park Forest in its first five years and how it was built. "<u>Step Back into a 1950s Christmas" with a display for Hanukkah and accomplishments of Jewish residents opens November 30and runs through January 4.</u> It makes an Incredible shared experience for families.
